VILLAGE OF WHITING-UTILITIES

WITH A POPULATION OF 1,760, THE VILLAGE OF WHITING IS LOCATED BETWEEN THE CITY OF STEVENS POINT AND THE VILLAGE OF PLOVER. CONSISTING OF PRIMARILY RESIDENTIAL USERS, THE VILLAGE DOES HAVE SOME COMMERCIAL DISCHARGERS AND SELLS WATER TO THE TWO LOCAL PAPER COMPANIES FOR PRODUCTION.

WHITING RECENTLY COMPLETED A \$5 MILLION (APPROXIMATE) WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY UPGRADE. TAKING AN OLD MANUAL CONVENTIONAL ACTIVATED SLUDGE PLANT AND CONVERTING IT INTO AN AUTOMATED EXTENDED AERATION PROCESS. ALSO INCLUDED IN THE UPGRADE WERE REMOTE OPERATION/MONITORING OF LIFT STATIONS, WATER TREATMENT PLANT, PUMPHOUSES, AND WATER TOWER. WE CURRENTLY RECEIVE ABOUT 0.3MGD OF FLOW.
