Wisconsin Rapids WWTP

Wisconsin Rapids' WWTP treats sewage from Wisconsin Rapids, the Village of Biron, and the Village of Rudolph. The plant has a capacity of 5.16 million gallons per day and treats an average of 3 million gallons per day. Department personnel are responsible for 130 miles of sanitary sewers and 17 lift stations.
