



TUITION AID CRITERIA FOR THE SOUTHERN REGION

The purpose of tuition aid is to encourage the continued education of WWOA Southern members through the attendance of Wisconsin DNR approved advanced course work related to wastewater treatment or for credit courses at an accredited university, college or technical school while working towards a degree related to the wastewater/water industry.

REQUIREMENTS and CRITERIA:

1. Member of WWOA Southern Region in good standing for a minimum of three (3) years.
2. The Southern Region will offer a maximum of two (2) \$250.00 tuition aid payments that will be awarded per school year, with maximum lifetime payments not to exceed \$1,000.00 for any one member.
3. Each recipient will be limited to one (1) tuition aid payment per school year. The school year is defined as beginning September 1st and ending on August 31st of the following year.
4. Written notification of conditional acceptance or denial for tuition aid will be made by the Southern Region Scholarship Committee within 10 working days of receipt of tuition aid application.
5. Tuition aid recipients must provide proof of successful completion for each seminar and/or course before tuition aid reimbursement payment will be paid. Recipients must submit the necessary documentation to the WWOA Executive Secretary within 30 days of seminar and/or course completion.
6. The applicant understands the Southern Region Tuition Aid Committee will only honor written communications, originating within the Committee, and duly signed by the Southern Region Tuition Aid Committee Chairperson. The applicant will submit all questions in writing pertaining to the processing of this application to the WWOA Executive Secretary for dissemination to the Southern Region Scholarship Committee. All discussions relative to this application shall be limited to: the tuition aid applicant, the WWOA Executive Secretary and the Southern Region Tuition Aid Committee.
